5.2 NEW YORK **Christian Siriano** presents a glamorously dark collection. A muted palette paired with experimental tailoring set the tone at **Duckie Brown**. The girls at **Vena Cava** look to the 90s for inspiration, channeling Kate Moss. **Rag & Bone's** woman is an urban nomad dressed for an Arctic winter. Menswear inspired looks play with feminine proportions at **Richard Chai Love**. See an early **DKNY** collection and then hit the catwalk for the label's youthful Brit mod look.

5.3 NEW YORK **Prabal Gurung** brings Lady Havisham of *Great Expectations* to life. The Duke of Windsor's eclectic way of dressing in herringbone waistcoats, cable knits and tartan kilts at **Rag & Bone Men's**. **Peter Som** stocks up on the practical. Native American motifs with modernity at **ADAM**. **Charlotte Ronson** remixes 90s grunge with 70s bohemian. Catch **Tommy Hilfinger's** collection from Fall 2000 and then see the cool 70s rocker girlfriend inspired collection.

5.4 NEW YORK **BCBG MaxAzria** applies 70s colorblocking to minimalism. Inspired by Beverly Semmes, **Doo.Ri** focused on elongated silhouettes. **Billy Reid** debuts womenswear alongside his tailored menswear. The San Francisco arts and crafts movement inspired **Preen by Thornton Bregazzi**. Spurred by the late 60s Italian films of Luchino Visconti, **Robert Geller** presents a dusty hued collection. Visit **Anna Sui** in Fall 1994, and then head on over to her latest collection.

5.5 NEW YORK **The Heart Truth Red Dress** highlights red designer gowns for a worthy cause. **Sophie Theallet** channels Faye Dunaway in "Bonnie & Clyde". The **Herve Leger by Max Azria** woman gets a sexy suit of armor. The "elder" lady serves as a colorful muse at **Suno**. **Dennis Basso** pushes the boundaries of fur. See **Marc Jacobs'** first-ever runway show and then catch his latest collection with campy polka dots, suggestive latex and mock croc on austere silhouettes.

5.6 NEW YORK **Derek Lam** offers ultra chic sportswear. Urban streetwear at **Nicholas K**. Scandinavian winters is the theme at **Gant by Michael Bastian**. **Yeohlee** materializes the sculpture of sound. The cleverly melded tribal styles of Masai, Rococo and New York at **Thakoon**. Take a look back at **Diane von Furstenberg** from Fall 1999 and then skip over to Fall 2011 to see her celebrate the strength and allure of venerable muses such as Gloria Vanderbilt and Millicent Rogers.

5.11 MILAN **Gucci's** 90th anniversary brings intense colors and sexy glamour. Sweet yet tough looks at **Missoni**. **DSquared2** treks to "Cold Mountain"! **Alessandro dell'Acqua** nods to 60s sirens at **No. 21**. **Just Cavalli** adds a 70s flair with prints, furs, denim and tweed. See what makes **Giorgio Armani** the unrivaled king of Italian fashion, then view his latest blush toned 'Boudoir' collection.

5.12 MILAN **Fendi** paints a collage with an art student themed collection. The Hitchcockian 60s are reinterpreted into modern experimental pieces at **Bottega Veneta**. Ultimately inspired by her own style sense, **Malandrino** presents an uber-chic hybrid of French and downtown New York. At the **Agent Provocateur** store opening, lingerie never looked this risqué. Watch a Olivier Theyskens' career retrospective then see the Parisian fashion darling debut his **Theyskens' Theory** women's collection in New York. Meet pouty-lipped model **Anais Pouliot!**

5.27 PARIS **Vivienne Westwood** portrays her "World Wide Woman" as an eccentric amalgamation of globally conscious style. **Rochas** returned to subtle elegance this season, defining "chic" through navy hues and classic blazer jackets. Visit Fall 1986 with **Azzedine Alaïa**. **Balmain** trades in traditional punk for glam rock. Plus, meet Norwegian catwalk beauty, **Siri Tollerod!**
